The Green Transition Investment Program (GTIP)

(GTIP) is a 3-year, EUR 2 million initiative by the GGGI in cooperation with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) of Finland to deepen the partnership between Finland and selected ASEAN partner countries. GTIP's overarching objective is to accelerate the countries' transition towards a green economy targeting, **circular economy start-up ecosystem, downstream waste management infrastructure and sustainable forest management investments**, while generating significant green employment in the recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic through **targeted green Investment and Technical & Vocational Education & Training components**.
